July 1st will be a special day for Trophies 'N Tees, an engraving, screen printing and sign shop in Downtown Safford, because that date marks the store's 20th anniversary.

Janet Oesterling and her first husband, Dalton Curtis, bought Van Leuven's Award & Engraving in 1991. Janet and Dalton wanted a business name that did not reflect their personal names. "We named it Trophies 'N Tees because that's what we did," Janet recalled.

Dalton and Janet, childhood sweethearts, had always dreamed of working together at their own business. Dalton passed away and Janet continued with the help of her son, Michael Curtis. "My son has worked with me every day for 20 years," Janet said adding that her grandchildren are beginning to help at the shop.

Trophies 'N Tees specializes in engraved trophies and plaques, screen printing, embroidery, vinyl banners and signs. Promotional products, such as pens and pencils, are also available. "Once we have our customers' logos, we can do a multitude of things with them," Janet said.

One state-of-art service is laser engraving made possible with a modern laser engraver. "It can engrave on anything. It engraves on paper," Janet said. The laser engraver and other equipment are a far cry from the tools used in Trophies 'N Tees' early years. There were no computers then. In contrast the business has about a dozen computers today.

Trophies 'N Tees has about 10 employees including Janet and Michael Curtis. Janet said she is passionate about her work and enjoys working every day. "I come down here, and the industry fascinates me. There's no end to the variety," Janet said. "I'll be down here with my walker."
